LCC TEXAS TOUR JUNE 16-24, 2022 TENTATIVE ITINERARY

DAY ONE - THURSDAY, JUNE 16 - Early morning departure on 2-55 passenger Imperial Travel motorcoaches, travel to St. Louis, MO. Tour the Arch Museum, group box lunch, one-hour riverboat cruise on the Mississippi and ride to the top of the Gateway Arch. Possible group meal and evening concert. Overnight stay in hotel in St. Louis. (Approximate mileage: 310 miles/5.25 hours/Central Time)

DAY TWO - FRIDAY, JUNE 17 - Travel to Tulsa, OK with lunch (on own) en route. Visit and possible short informal concert at Tulsa Botanical Gardens. Dinner on own and overnight stay in Tulsa. (Approximate total mileage: 394 miles/7 hours/Central Time)

DAY THREE – SATURDAY, JUNE 18 – Travel to Dallas/Fort Worth, TX. Lunch (on own) en route. Visit the Fort Worth Stockyards for the cattle drive, shoot out, shopping and dinner; travel to (30 minutes) and check into the Gaylord Texan Resort* for the Texas International Choral Festival (Approximate mileage: 301 miles/5 hours/Central Time)

DAY FOUR - SUNDAY, JUNE 19 - Note: All festival rehearsals, meals, & activities will take place at the Gaylord Texan Resort* unless noted otherwise. Morning festival rehearsal; welcome group lunch, festival workshop/clinic, and afternoon rehearsal & free time; evening welcome group dinner and dance (Same hotel as day three.)

DAY FIVE – MONDAY, JUNE 20 – Morning festival rehearsal; group lunch; afternoon workshop/clinic and free time; evening group dinner and additional free time to enjoy the resort amenities (Same hotel as days three and four)

DAY SIX – TUESDAY, JUNE 21 – Morning free time; group lunch & afternoon festival rehearsal at the Meyerson Concert Hall in downtown Dallas; group dinner; 6:30 PM Texas International Choral Festival Concert featuring massed choir and individual choir performances; return to Gaylord Texan for singer farewell (Same hotel as days three, four, & five.)

DAY SEVEN - WEDNESDAY, JUNE 22 - Travel to Memphis, TN; visit and possible informal performance at Memphis Zoo including private group dinner at the zoo. Overnight stay in Memphis. (Approximate mileage: 475 miles/8.5 hours/Central Time)

DAY EIGHT – THURSDAY, JUNE 23 – Travel to Jasper, IN with scenic stops and lunch (on your own); check into hotel; evening farewell concert at St. Joseph Church in Jasper OR Immaculate Conception Monastery in Ferdinand; evening group farewell dinner (possibly at the Schnitzelbank German restaurant) in Jasper. (Approximate mileage: 381 miles/7 hours/Eastern Time)

DAY NINE – FRIDAY, JUNE 24 - Travel to Holiday World & Splashin' Safari (22 miles/30 minutes/Central Time) for morning through mid-afternoon visit (lunch voucher included); travel home to Logansport. (Approximate mileage: 227 miles/4 hours)

During the festival, adults/chaperones will have free time to enjoy the resort any time the singers have rehearsal or workshops/clinics.

*The festival hotel is subject to change but will still be a resort-type accommodation.
